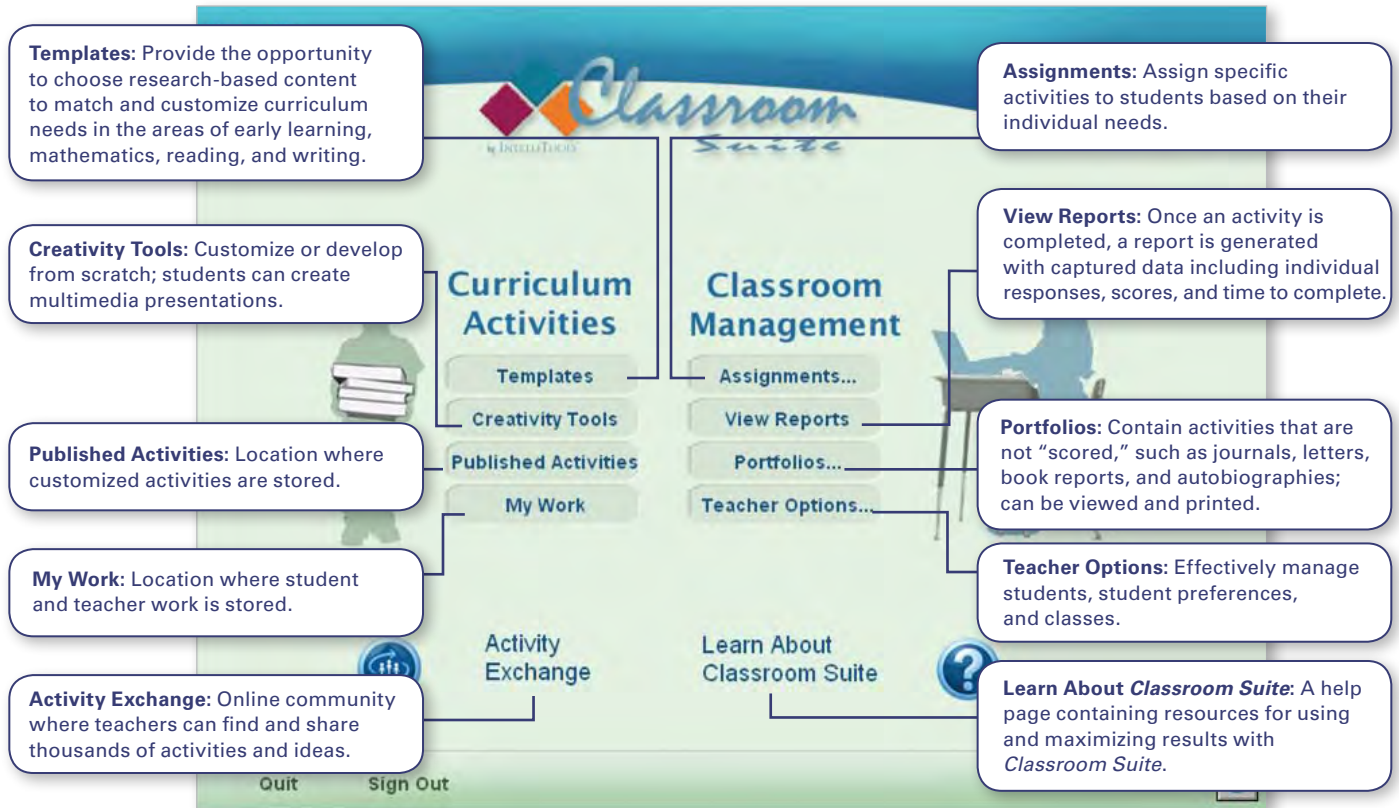

Model, Practice, Apply

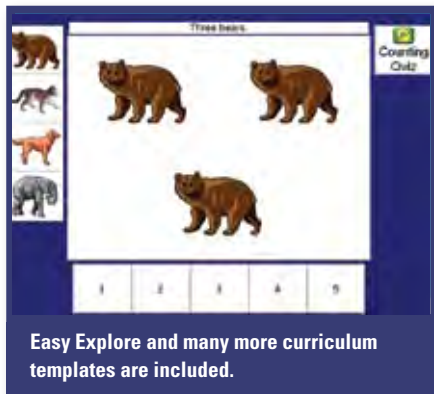
Classroom Suite performs like an excellent instructor. Great teachers give direction (Model), support guided practice with their class (Practice), and then turn the reins over to their students (Apply). With *Classroom Suite*, students are led through three stages:

-  **Show Me**—The computer plays a video-like sequence to orient the student to the lesson
-  **Practice**—The student practices and learns as the software provides strategic and corrective feedback
-  **Challenge**—The educational objective is identical to “Practice,” but the corrective feedback is withdrawn, and data is collected for reports

If the student displays mastery in Challenge, he/she moves on to the next activity. If the student fails to master the assignment, he/she receives more practice with more strategic feedback.

Early learning activities for emergent learners

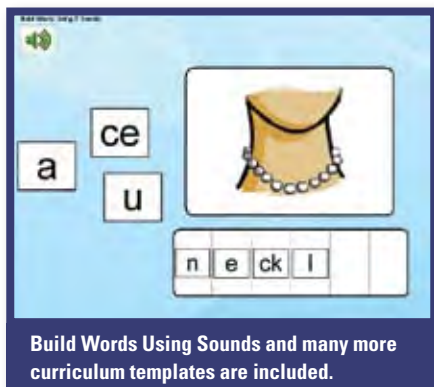

Reading activities in all five areas

The NRP found that there are five key areas of reading instruction: phonemic awareness, phonics, text fluency, vocabulary, and reading comprehension. *Classroom Suite* addresses all of these areas and is an ideal tool for creating reading interventions based on *DIBELS® (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills)* screening data.



Templates include:


- **Build Words Using Sounds:** Allows teachers to construct activities in which students build words as they practice letter-sound correspondence
- **Match Sounds:** Allows teachers to create activities in which students match words based on their beginning, middle, ending, or rime
- **Build Fluency:** Allows teachers to create activities in which students read and record single-word, phrase, or sentence passages
- **Build Vocabulary:** Allows teachers to create activities that build students' vocabulary by using definitions, synonyms, representative graphics, and sample sentences

Writing activities to engage and empower

The scaffolded writing instruction integrated into *Classroom Suite* helps students master the stages of the writing process (brainstorming, organizing, drafting, editing, and publishing) and provides opportunities for learning to write in various genres.

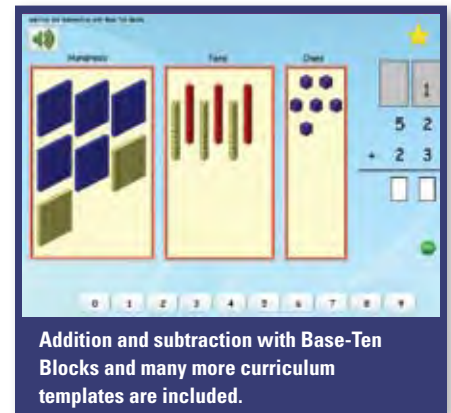
Math activities for building core skills and mastering concepts

The math interactions in *Classroom Suite* are based on research in math models and automaticity. 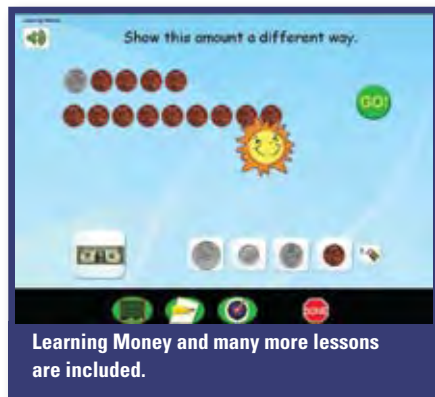

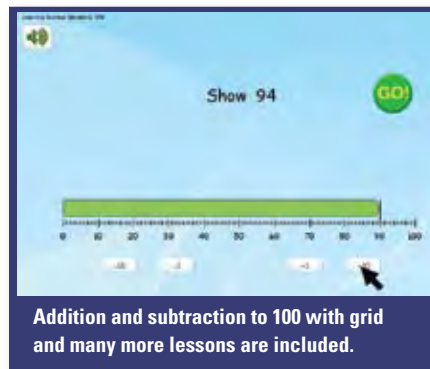

- Students should develop immediate recall of arithmetic facts to free the “working memory” for solving more complex problems
- Students need to build conceptual understanding, computational and procedural fluency, and problem-solving skills. These skills are equally important and mutually reinforce one another
- Students need proficiency with whole numbers and fractions as a foundation for success in algebra
