
Create Your Own Customized Picture Dictionary


Kurzweil 3000 comes with the Kurzweil 3000 Picture Dictionary in English and Spanish of over 1300 illustrations and photos, as well as a sample set from the Mayer-Johnson PCS library. Follow these steps to create your own Picture Dictionary with your own pictures including the following formats: .bmp, .gif, .ico, .jpg or .jpeg, .tiff and wmf.

1. Create a folder with pictures. Make sure the pictures are named so that when the student highlights a name in a document the picture will appear as a choice. Or locate a file of pictures you already own: ASL or Mayer Johnson PCS Symbols.

 Open the Picture Dictionaries dialog box and click New. (References->Select Dictionary->Picture Dictionary-> Setup).



3. Click New.



4. Click **Browse** and navigate to your **folder** with pictures.

(This could be a folder of your own pictures, the Mayer-Johnson picture symbol folder, the Vcom3d Animated ALS gif folder, ANY folder of pictures.)

- 5. Name the folder Click OK.
- 6. Click **OK** to close the window.
- 7. In your document, select a word, click on the Picture button, a window will appear with pictures.
